

You will need: Tape or glue (I recommend tape), a pair of scissors, and some good light. With your scissors, cut out the mouse's four pieces — face, body, tail and whiskers — by following the solid black lines. Now, fold all the blue squiggly lines back, away from you. Fold all the red squiggly lines up, toward you. By now, it'll be pretty obvious where the tabs go. Put the body together by sticking A to A and B to B. Attach the face (C to C and D to D). Stick the whiskers under the chin (E to E). Finally, stick the tail into the notch just below the A tab (F to F). Your DIY Mouse is now complete!
